Who is coming to Holiday Club?

Holiday Club is open to any primary school aged children who live locally. Sue will be managing Easter Holiday Club, with Sheena each morning and Ghazalah each afternoon. Lesley will be there to help out some of the time.

Staff will try to give parents/carers a brief outline of their child's day at pick-up time but just ask if you need more detail.

Arrivals and departures

Enter and leave using **BALMORAL ROAD** gate. Come round the left of the building to the red double doors to the dining hall.



One of us will be at the dining hall door to welcome children between 08:30 and 09:00.

If you bring siblings who are not attending club with you to drop off or collect, please keep them with you.

You'll usually collect your children from the same place at the end of their session. Just look out for the Holiday Club Board.

Just before 15:30 and 17:00, a Knutz Club staff member will bring the children due to leave to the door ready for collection.

Parents/carers should arrive on time to collect children and to leave promptly with them.

Remember to tell us if you plan to drop off or collect your child outside of these times.

If the gate is closed and we are not in sight just call the club number **07908 353041** and we will respond as soon as we can. Please do NOT buzz as the school office is closed.

If you are delayed, phone us straight away to let us know what alternative arrangements you have made for collection. There are charges for late collection from Holiday Club.

Be prepared whatever the weather - we will be outside as much as possible!



Please make sure that your children come dressed to play. Comfy clothes, like sweatshirts, T shirts & trousers are best.

They need comfortable shoes or trainers with straps or laces for running around outside, riding on bikes or scooters and going on the climbing frame.

Do check the weather: if it is cold or rainy, send a jacket & jumper. If children arrive in wellies, they will need shoes for indoors too. If it is sunny children might need a hat or suncream.

Remember the children will be playing outside and they might get messy or dirty.

Child Safety, Health and Hygiene

We aim for everyone to stay safe at Holiday Club. To protect children and adults we will take the following steps:

We will try to keep the playground gates and external door closed. Please wait at the club board and we will collect or return your children there. Usually this will be at the dining hall.

There may be tradesmen in school doing planned maintenance. Staff will supervise children while they play and we will expect children to stay in the areas we ask them to play.

Staff will ask children to wash their hands thoroughly, before food, after using a tissue and after going to the toilet.

We will check and clean the areas children use during the day.

Our play areas will be arranged to allow ventilation and avoid overcrowding.

We will be outside in the fresh air as much as possible, usually on KS1 playground.

You are responsible for keeping us updated on your child's current health information.

We can only give medication to children if you provide the medication and have completed a permission to administer medication form for each medication.

N.B. Children may not attend club if they are unwell. If your child vomits or has diarrhoea, they can return 48 hours after the last incidence.

If your child becomes unwell at Club, we will call you. You will need to arrange to collect them without delay.

Food and drinks

Each child will need a water bottle, just for WATER during the day. We will provide

Breakfast 08:45 to 09:15 – toast, cereals, milk. Mid-morning snack 10:45 – a piece of fruit

Lunch 12:30 to 13:00 – a 'packed' lunch, something different each day such as a bagel, wraps, rolls, sandwich, some crisps, some veg/salad. Perhaps cheese, chicken, cheese spread, egg mayo, tuna fish or hummus according to children's dietary requirements. Fruit, a yoghurt or a jelly or a cake or biscuit.

Mid-afternoon snack 15:00 – milk and a biscuit. Late snack 16:15 – crackers or rice cakes

Please do not send any food or other drinks, the children will bring them home.

What shall we do at Holiday Club?

Children will be able to make up their own games and play and have fun with their friends. We will ask children what they want to do each day and try to do something for everyone.

Children should not bring any toys or any valuables to Club.
