Who is coming to Holiday Club?

Holiday Club is open to any primary school aged children who live locally. Our Knutz Club staff will be working in shifts during Holiday Club. Staff will be able to give parents/carers a brief outline of their child's day at pick-up time but just ask if you need more detail and would like Lesley to call you.

Arrivals and departures

Enter and leave via **BALMORAL ROAD** pedestrian gate. Come in the gate and turn right towards the office.

We will welcome children at the playground gate from 08:30.

Collect your children from the same place at the end of their session.

Parents/carers should arrive on time to collect children and to leave promptly.

You do need to tell us if you plan to drop off or collect your child outside of these times.

If the gate is closed and we are not in sight just call the club number **07908 353041** and we will respond as soon as we can. Please do NOT buzz as the school office is not staffed.

If you are delayed, phone us straight away to let us know what alternative arrangements you have made for collection.

Be prepared whatever the weather - remember, we will be outside as much as possible!



Please make sure that your children come appropriately dressed to play. T shirts and shorts or trousers are best.

They need sensible shoes or trainers with straps or laces for running around outside, riding on bikes or scooters and going on the climbing frame.

They may well get messy or dirty.

Do check the weather yourself so your children are suitably prepared.

Health and Hygiene

We aim for everyone to stay healthy during Summer Holiday Club. To protect children and adults we are still taking the following steps:

- Please wait at the welcome point and we will collect or return your children there
- Staff will ask children to wash their hands thoroughly at appropriate times
- The Club will take place outside in the fresh air as much as possible

You are responsible for keeping us updated on your child's current health information. **We can only give medication to children if you provide the medication and complete a permission to administer medication form for each medication.**

Children may not attend club if they are unwell. If your child vomits or has diarrhoea, they can return 48 hours after the last incidence.

If your child becomes unwell at Club, we will call you to collect them without delay.

GET WET! Sessions

One of the favourite features of the Summer Club is our **Get Wet!** water play.



We turn on the sprinkler and get out the water pistols for about half an hour before or after lunch time. Children run around in the clothes they wore to club and everyone has fun and gets soaking wet.

Afterwards, children get dried and dressed in their dry clothes.



IMPORTANT: Bring a towel, a complete set of dry clothes and suitable footwear to join in!

Food and drinks

Each child will need a water bottle, just for WATER during the day. They should not bring any other food or drinks. We will provide a morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack. Drinking water will be available at all times and milk will be offered with snacks.

What to wear and bring to club

- Children should wear comfy clothes and shoes or trainers to play in.
- Bring a jacket, cardigan or shirt to cover up and wear sun hat or cap.
- Slop on the sunscreen before children arrive and send some to top up later and after water play.
- Children should not bring their own toys or any valuables to Club.
